Welcome to the Jungle! We are excited to get to know your child. In this room we have 15 – 27 months old and there are two teachers with a ratio of 1 – 5. We start our day with a little free play as our friends are dropped off. We offer small little projects, games, reading books and singing as they play. After snack the teachers will split the group into two and work on our lesson plan activities. These activities range from large motor, small motor, art, science, language and math skills. Colors, shapes, animals and their sounds and body movements are fun too. They will learn so many things in a very short amount of time that you will be surprised. Below you will find some helpful hints to make the transition easier.



Drop Off

Sign your child in and put their items in their cubby.

Bring your child to a teacher. Our opening room is the infant room. When enough staff comes in, we move to our room.



Pick up

We may be outside on our playground, in our classroom or in the infant room depending on the weather and time of day of pick up. Please sign your child out each day. Take home belongings from your child's cubby nightly. (crafts, notes, daily reports)

Daily Schedule

During preschool time, we work on our lesson plan that is posted on the bulletin board just outside the room. Your copy goes home weekly, please hang your copy of the lesson plan somewhere you can go over the daily activity with your child before you come to school.



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Nap Time

A blanket to cuddle with is necessary at nap time. This is the only time during the day we allow pacifiers. If your child needs one during nap, please bring one that can stay at the center. We work on breaking the pacifier habit no later than early summer so that the child is ready to move to the next classroom with no problems.

Extra Clothes

At least one extra outfit (shirt, pants, socks), is necessary. Wearing shoes is another necessity for play. We spend a great deal of time outside.

During the winter we will need snowsuits, boots, gloves and hats. We love being outside.

Assessments

We assess the children twice a year. The first few weeks of September and April of the next year. We will be happy to set a conference date and time for you.
